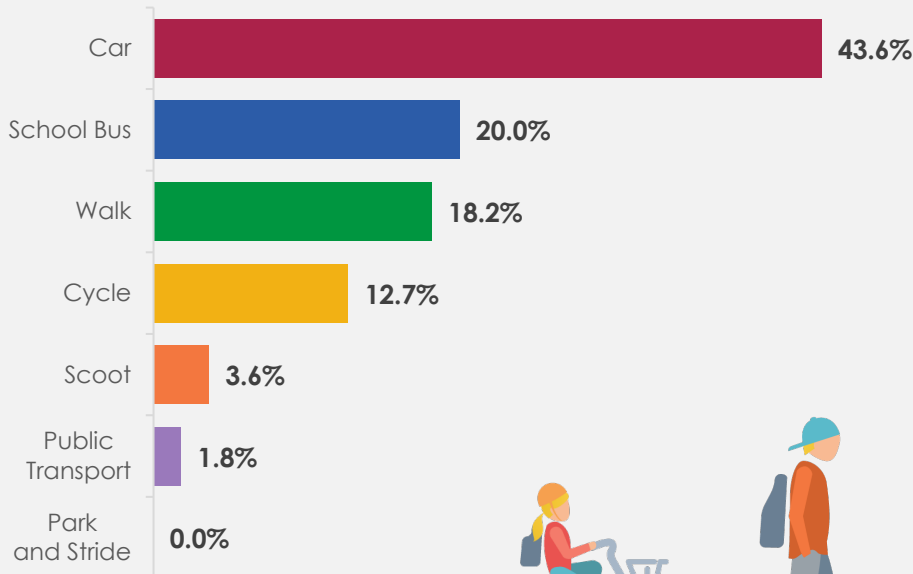
Results of Our Travel Survey

Responses received: 40

Students represented: 55

Our school has been selected to participate in the Safe School Zones project. The objective of the project is to improve safety at the school gate and to support students to safely walk, cycle and scoot to school. The results of the Travel Survey and support for the Safe School Zones project are presented below.

How We Travel To School



85.0% of respondents agreed that road safety is a problem around the school

97.5% of respondents would support works at the front of school that improve student safety

97.5% of respondents would support works that improve the walking and cycling routes to our school

Some key comments received

"Cars currently double park at the school gates. This blocks not only the estate road but out onto the main road also. It also reduces visibility for pedestrians and cyclists."

"Somewhere for the buses to park so not to block the entrance as the kids just walk out in front of the bus every day, there is no zebra crossing and it is very unsafe for the kids to cross the road"

Next Steps

SDCC will study the findings of the survey and develop a proposal for safety interventions at the school gate.
