

You are invited to take part in this public consultation process by submitting your views and suggestions for a new, updated County Heritage Plan 2016-2022. In formulating your submissions, you may wish to consider the following:

- What would you like to see included in a revised County Heritage Plan?
- In what ways do you think a new Heritage Plan might advance objectives and actions to protect and promote the County's rich heritage resource?
- What facilities or heritage support services would you like to see developed as part of a new updated County Heritage Plan?
- How could community engagement with heritage initiatives be improved and enhanced, both for the benefit of local residents and visitors to the County?
- Could elements of the County's heritage resource be sensitively developed in order to deliver an economic return e.g. via local and community tourism initiatives?

The final Plan will be a statement of strategy, dealing with heritage issues on a county-wide basis. Over the 6-year life time of the new Plan annual work programmes will prioritise projects to meet the objectives listed in the Plan.

Review of the County Heritage Plan 2010-2015

A review of the South Dublin County Council's Heritage Plan 2010-2015 is currently underway. Many of the current Plan's 79 actions addressing the County's natural, archaeological, architectural, geological, and cultural heritage have been achieved over its five years of operation. These actions and projects have added to our knowledge and appreciation of the County's heritage resource.

Input to Council's policies and objectives regarding all aspects of the County's heritage



The current review of the Plan will identify any unaddressed actions in the existing Plan and, in addition to new ideas and suggestions that will emerge from this consultation process, a revised and updated County Heritage Plan 2016-2022 will be prepared.
