

Context

South Dublin Council intends to review the land use planning framework governing the future development and operation of Weston Aerodrome with reference to changing European safety requirements, economic development opportunities for the County and the impact on neighbouring residential communities. This shall be carried out in accordance with the requirements of Policy IE9 Objective 6 of the Development Plan 2016 – 2022 (page 139).

Zoning

Weston Aerodrome is zoned 'RU' which seeks 'To protect and improve rural amenity and to provide for the development of agriculture'.



Potential issues for consideration

- **Future Development:** Are there potential development opportunities for Weston Aerodrome to be developed, having regard to changing European safety requirements and the residential amenity of neighbouring communities?
- **Economic Development:** Are there any future development opportunities at Western Aerodrome which could contribute to the sustainable development of the County.
- **Capacity for tourism:** Are there any opportunities for tourism and recreational potential at Weston Aerodrome which could benefit the County.

The purpose of this process is to prepare a review of the land use planning framework governing the future development and operation of Weston Aerodrome.
