H1 Objective 13	H1 Objective 13: Proposals for residential development shall provide a minimum of 30% 3-bedroom units, <b>unless it can be demonstrated that a lesser provision may be acceptable where it can be demonstrated that:</b>	<p>This amendment seriously dilutes the intent and benefit to deliver a truly diverse mix of unit sizes in higher density settings. The developers have shown they will continue to drive towards a high percentage of 1 beds and studios unless there is a strong objective in the governing plan.</p> <p>The notion that this standard would not apply to the council itself seriously undermines the spirit and the principle of this objective,</p>	Strongly reject this amendment.
Amendment 6.5	Amend to H7 Objective 3	H7 Objective 3: To support the principle of permeability schemes that provide improved connections between housing estates and their surrounds for walking and cycling whilst taking account of anti-social behaviour, and only progressing vehicle permeability schemes where necessary. , having regard to the National Transport Authority's Permeability Best Practice Guide (2015) or any subsequent guidelines, including the provisions relating to permeability schemes and anti-social behaviour.	We are concerned at the dilution of controlling vehicular access where there are known hot spots for anti social behaviour.
