

01 SITE LOCATION

The site is located within walking distance from Lucan Village, at the Sluice Carpark, in close proximity to the River Liffey.



02 SITE CONTEXT



The current park access to the Lucan Demense Park consists of a steep tarmac path from the carpark to the riverside pathway.

The proposal is to replace this path with an accessible timber boardwalk to enable better access to Lucan Demense.

The existing trees & vegetation are being retained as part of the proposal.

The boardwalk will compliment current proposals underway in the car park area, immediately external to the entrance.

The inspiration for this boardwalk is derived from similar projects in Ireland such as Avondale Tree Top Walk pictured below.






LANDSCAPE MASTERPLAN & SECTIONS


Site Layout



An east-west illustration of proposed landscape


