Clondalkin experiences gridlock most school days at opening and closing times and the proposals will exacerbate the situation.

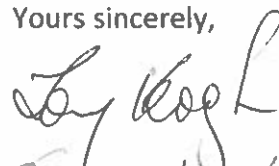

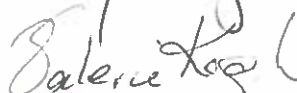
We object to the following

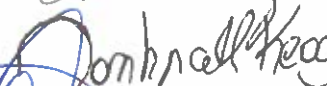
1. Narrowing the junction between Orchard Rd and Monastery Rd.
