

HERITAGE AND BIODIVERSITY PLANS FOR SOUTH DUBLIN COUNTY

South Dublin County Council is commencing a pre-draft consultation process to prepare the County's first Biodiversity Action Plan and to review and update its current County Heritage Plan 2010-2015.

The new County Heritage Plan and the County Biodiversity Plan will be six-year programmes, listing a range of agreed objectives and actions to address matters of heritage and biodiversity interest across South Dublin County. It is an opportunity to identify and address heritage and biodiversity issues at a local level while working within a regional and a national framework.
